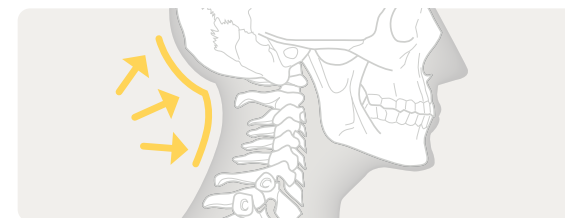

Compression Therapy



The Vista MultiPost Therapy Collar provides therapeutic support to the neck to promote better posture. The hot/cold therapy pack directs the location of the compression to help reduce inflammation and unlock tight muscles, providing soothing relief.

As your head moves forward out of alignment, gravitational forces are magnified causing neck muscles and structures to overwork. For every inch that the head protrudes from its normal position, the neck must support ten additional pounds of force (Dr. Adalbert I. Kapandji, author of "The Physiology of the Joints").² The greater the misalignment, the greater the chance of significant problems such as:

- Restricted mobility
- Cervical symptoms
- Neck and shoulder pain
- Migraines
- Radiculopathy
- Jaw pain

FAQ

How do I activate the compression?

Squeeze the pump located on the front of the collar until desired compression is reached. The compression can be reduced by pressing the release valve located next to the pump.

How long do I need to wear the collar?
